Dr. David Deaton specializes in vascular surgery at MedStar Georgetown University Hospital with clinical expertise in endovascular aortic grafting, carotid and renal stenting, lower extremity endovascular bypass, peripheral endovascular therapy, carotid, renal, aortic and lower extremity surgery. A 1985 graduate of Duke University School of Medicine, Dr. Deaton completed his residency at the Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania, and his fellowship at the University of California Los Angeles. He received his certification in vascular surgery in 1995.

Dr. Deaton has worked on the development of numerous medical devices and provided the FDA testimony for the first aortic endograft approved in the United States. He has been a primary investigator in clinical trials for aortic aneurysm, carotid and lower extremity vascular disease.
